The Background to Mark’s Kingdom Announcement

1. The King has a Kingdom, and He deserves to be praised
Psalm 96:1-4; Genesis 1-3; 2 Cor. 4:4; Luke 19:10
2. God’s preferred pattern of the Kingdom perished with sin
Psalm 103:19; Gen. 1:26-30; 3:4-5
3. People can reconnect to God’s promised Kingdom by faith
Gen. 12:1-2; 15:6; Rom. 4:1-5; Matt. 11:28-30
4. God is gracious to His people even in their unbelief and rewards the obedient and faithful
Judges 17:6; Joshua 24:15, 31
5. God proclaims His Kingdom through His leaders
1 Sam. 8:4-7; 9:1-2; Acts 13:22
6. God promises hope even when it looks hopeless
Psalm 137:1-4; Daniel 3:17, 24-25; Joel 2:32
7. The hope is in Jesus
Isaiah 53:5-6; Matt. 5:31-36
