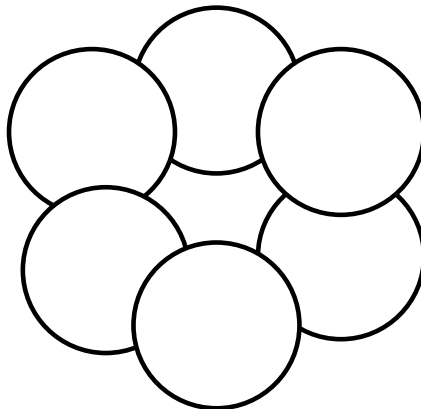
### God’s Wave Makers...

1. **Are** conduits for God’s power.

- Be active in ministry (Acts 9:23-33)
- Be available for ministry (Acts 9:36-39)
- Be accepting of God as the focus (Acts 9:40-43)



1. Comprehend where God is at work.

- In our own lives (vv. 9-16)

2. Convert our perspective when needed.
