2. God cares enough to rescue _____ me.

I can be rescued from...

- (the guilt of the past)

“Christ came with this new agreement so that all who are invited may come and have forever all the wonders God has promised them. For Christ died to rescue them from the penalty of the sins they had committed....” **Heb. 9:15 (LB)**

- (the meaninglessness of life)

- (the fear of death)
