Verse 12

- The LORD measures:
- Water
- Sky-heavens
- Dust of the earth
- Mountains

Verse 30-31: two groups

- The strong young:
 - Will grow tired and weary
 - They will stumble
- Those who expect:
 - Will renew their strength
 - Grow wings
 - Will not be weary or tired

Tired and weary

- V.28 – God does not grow tired / weary
- V.30 – Human beings grow tired / weary
- V.31 – those who expect shall not grow weary / tired
