Background to the Text



God works through...

1. Ordinary people

"Then <u>Joshua</u> son of Nun secretly sent <u>two spies</u> from Shittim. 'Go, look over the land,' he said, 'especially Jericho.'" (1:1)

examples:

Joshua → encouragement (Deut. 31:7; Joshua 1:5, 6, 7, 9, 18)

The Two Spies anonymous

unlikely Candidates .

example: Rahab

Strike #1: She was from the wrong side of the tracks

Strike #2: She was the wrong gender

Strike #3: She has a Stained reputation (2:1, 4, 5 cf. James 2:22-25)

Q: Is there something in the past or present that makes you an unlikely candidate for God to work through? (James 2:25; Romans 5:20)

3. people who live by faith.

(Joshua 2:1-7; Hebrews 11: 1-2, 6, 31)

faith is...

Characteristics of Rahab's Faith

- COUVAGEOUS (2 Kings 17:33; 1 Thes. 1:9; Hebrews 11:31; James 2:25)
- confident (Joshua 2:9)
- CONCEYNED (Joshua 2:12-14; Proverbs 11:30; Hebrews 7:25)
- committed (Joshua 2:15-24)
 - She became a mother. (Ruth 4:21; Mt. 1:5)
 - She is in the Hall of Faith. (Hebrews 11)
 - She is in the lineage of Jesus. (Mt. 1:5-6)
