Integrity is when my <u>actions</u> and my <u>words</u> consistently match <u>God's truth</u>. (Job 4:6; Prov. 10:9)

#### LAST WEEK: Important lessons about personal integrity

- 2. My integrity will have an impact.

"under the ban" = devoted to the Lord

### Achan's Negative Example (Joshua 6:17-18)

- a) We are never <u>isolated</u> in our personal failures. (Josh. 7:1)
- b) God sees our failures. (Proverbs 10:9; Num. 32:23; Gal 6:7)
- c) Personal failure typically is a <u>process</u> not an <u>evewt</u>. (Joshua 7:21)
  - Step #1 I saw the gold
  - Step #2 I wanted the gold
  - Step #3 I took the gold
  - Step #4 I híd the gold

#### Joshua's Positive Example (see Genesis 39:5-10)

- a) I can't do this, I would let myself down "How could I do this great evil..." (Gen. 39:9)
- b) I can't do this, I let those around me down "...he has put all that he owns in my charge..." (Gen. 39:8)
- c) I can't do this, I let God down "...and sin against God." (Gen. 39:9)

## 3. My integrity can be restored.

"O LORD, who may abide in Your tent? Who may dwell on Your holy hill? <sup>2</sup>He who walks with integrity, and works righteousness, And speaks truth in his heart." Psalm 15:1-2 (NASB)

"<u>He restores my soul</u>; He guides me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake." Psalm 23:3 (NASB)

"But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8 (NIV)
