When change happens...

Actions and motives are often misunderstood.

"...the sons of Reuben and the sons of Gad and the half-tribe of Manasseh built an altar there by the Jordan, a large altar in appearance." (v. 10)

The Concern for Unity Among God's People

- Our unity depends on <u>spiritual dedication</u>. (v. 5)
- Our unity demands that we <u>learn from the past</u>. (vv. 17-20; Deut. 12:5; Lev. 17:8-9)

2. <u>Success</u> is not immediate but expectations are.

"...In time to come <u>your sons may say to our sons</u>, 'What have you to do with the LORD, the God of Israel? For <u>the LORD has made</u> the Jordan a border between us and you'..." (vv. 24-25, NASB)

3. People are passionate during times of transition.

"All the Israelites became <u>very angry</u> at these three tribes, so they met together and decided to fight them." (v. 12, NCV)

We can avoid many of the pains of change by ...

Examining a person's history before passing judgment.

"You have done <u>everything</u> that Moses the Lord's servant ordered you to do, and <u>you have obeyed all my commands</u>." (v. 2, TEV)

Discovering the facts before we <u>act.</u>

"¹³ Then the sons of Israel sent...<u>Phinehas</u> the son of Eleazar the priest, ¹⁴ and with him ten chiefs, one chief for each father's household from each of the tribes of Israel; and each one of them was the head of his father's household among the thousands of Israel." (vv. 13-14)

Communicating honestly like a healthy family. (vv. 15-29)

Key Principles During Times of Change

- Seek first to <u>understand</u> then to be <u>understood</u>. (1 Peter 2:23)
- Communicate the truth. (v. 30)

Being gracious towards others.

"Share with your relatives back home the great wealth you have taken from your enemies." (v. 8, NLT)

Seeking God every step of the way. (vv. 5, 30-34) (James 3:17: 1 Timothy 5:21)
