Coming Together

Growing in Our Understanding

- Read Galatians 6:11-18. What does Paul say in these verses to let us know that this letter to Galatians was very personal for him?
- What seems to be the motivation for wanting Christians in the church at Galatia to be circumcised? See Galatians 6:12-13.
- What are some of signs in Galatian 6:12-14 that legalism is being lived out?
- What are some of the signs that grace is being lived out in the church? See Galatians 6:14-15.

- What does Paul mean by “new creation” in Galatian 6:15? See also 2 Corinthians 5:17.

Unwrapping and Applying God’s Principles

- What is legalism? How was it impacting the Galatian church? Do we see a similar impact or concern in church today?
- Some in the church at Galatia were bragging about their works of righteousness (see Gal. 6:13). Take a moment and read Matthew 6:1-2. How are we supposed to practice our good deeds?
- Read 1 Corinthians 1:20-25. What are the different reaction people have when the cross of Christ is taught on?

Deepening Our Hearts for God

- What were some of the most important lessons you learned in this series in the Book of Galatians?
- How would you summarize the main message of Paul’s letter to the Galatians?
