  - *Benevolence Tithe*  
Deuteronomy 14:28-29
  - *Additional Taxes*: Temple Tax, Profit Sharing Tax, Sabbath Rest Tax, Year of Restitution Tax  
Neh. 10:33; Lev. 19:9-10; Ex. 23:10-11; Deut. 15
  - *Voluntary Offerings*  
Leviticus 22:18-33; Num. 15:3; Deut. 12:6; Ex. 35:29
