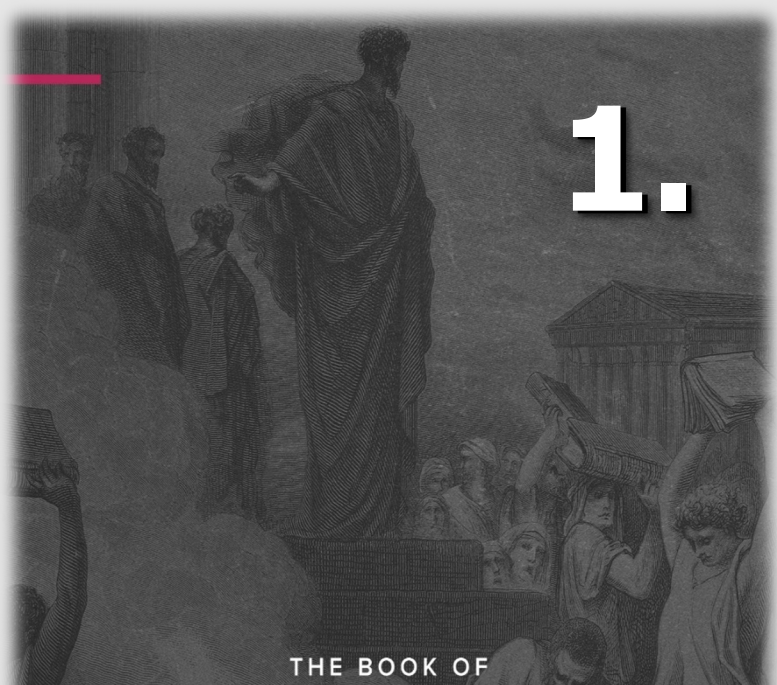

Faith is...

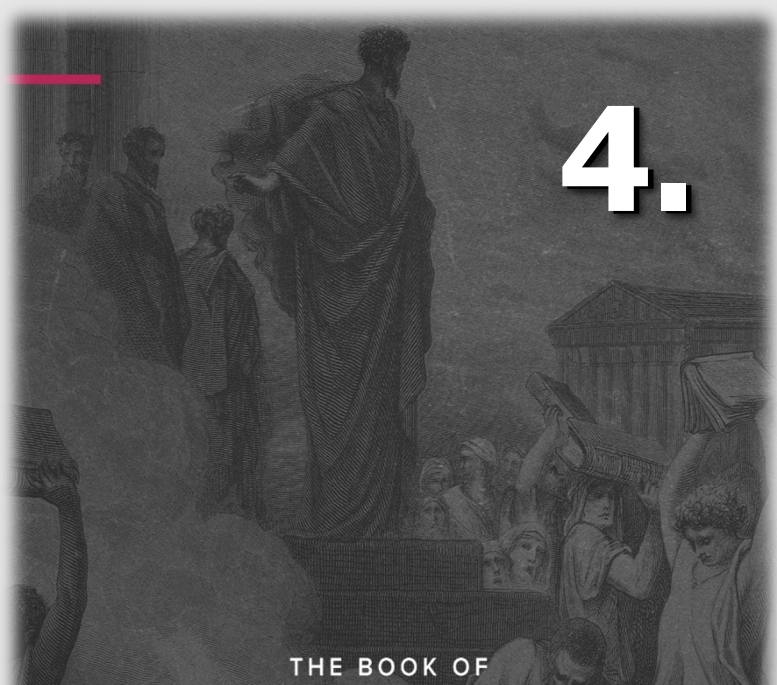
