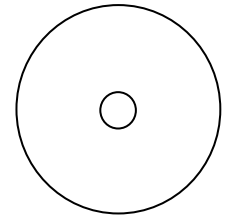


### The Law

God’s guidelines for living given to Moses in the Old Testament. These guidelines were eventually perverted into manufactured, religious traditions.

### The Promise

God’s Word that salvation is received by grace through faith. Genesis 12:1-3; 15:6; Ephesians 2:8-9



### The Problem

#1: The Judaizers wanted to add religious traditions to God’s promise of salvation. #2: Paul quotes from the OT six times (Gal. 3:1-14) to prove that salvation does not come by obeying religious traditions. If salvation does not involve the Law then why was it given and why did Paul quote from it?
