

The Law

God's guidelines for living given to Moses in the Old Testament. These guidelines were eventually perverted into manufactured, religious traditions.

The Promise

God's Word that salvation is received by grace through faith. Genesis 12:1-3; 15:6; Ephesians 2:8-9



The Problem

#1: The Judaizers wanted to add religious traditions to God's promise of salvation. #2: Paul quotes form the OT six times (Gal. 3:1-14) to prove that salvation does not come by obeying religious traditions. If salvation does not involve the Law then why was it given and why did Paul quote from it?
