- Read Acts 3:1-5. Where were Peter and John heading that day and for what purpose?
- What details does Luke give us about the man at the Gate called Beautiful?
- How did Peter and John respond to the Beggar's request? (Acts 3:4-6)
- How did the Beggar respond to his healing? How does the Beggar's response compare to the people who witnessed it? (Acts 3:7-11)
- Read Peter's Sermon in Acts 3:12-26. Circle, highlight, underline anything that stands out. What to you was striking or surprising in Peter's sermon to explain the Beggar's healing?

Unwrapping God's Principles

- What did Peter tell the audience to do in order to receive forgiveness of sin? What does "repentance" mean? (Acts 3:19).
- According to Peter in Acts 3 (vv. 6, 16), who has the power to do miracles and bring about healing?
- What does this passage do to shape how we react and treat those with obvious needs? What more can we do to help meet the needs of people?
- What would need to change for God to work through you and our church for God to use us to meet the real needs of people in our Valley?
