  - What does the Crowd do?
3. Why did the people spread their coats in Mark 11:8-10? How does 2 Kings 9:13 inform your answer?
4. What does the reaction of the Crowd in Mark 11:1-11 reveal to us about their expectations of Jesus?

### Unwrapping and Applying God's Principles

1. What do you think the Disciples thought about when Jesus asked them to go and get Him a colt (Mk 11:2-3)? Has God ever asked you to do something difficult or unusual? How did you respond?
2. According to Hebrews 11:1, 6, what is faith and how does it influence our response to God when He asks us to do something we do not understand?
3. The people on the parade route in Mark 11:1-11 were shouting "Hosanna," a term used to express their praise for God. What do you do to express your appreciation or praise of God?

### Deepening Our Hearts for God

- Have you ever had any expectations of Jesus that proved to be false? What helped correct your understanding of Jesus?
- Read Romans 8:28-29. Why do you think God does not always reveal His intentions or long-range plans for us when we find ourselves in difficult circumstances?
