Jesus Over Traditions

"And the Lord said:

'Because this people draw near with their mouth and honor me with their lips, while their hearts are far from me, and their fear of me is a commandment taught by men."



2. Religion often voids God's Word.

""8You leave the commandment of God and hold to the tradition of men.' 9 And he said to them, 'You have a fine way of rejecting the commandment of God in order to establish your tradition!"

Mark 7:8-9

Jesus Over Traditions

"See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ."



Traditions become dangerous when...

they blind us

Traditions become corrupt when...

we pursue them over God's Word

Supremacy of God's Word
