

The Suffering Servant

"42 And Jesus called them to him and said to them, 'You know that those who are considered rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. ⁴³But it shall not be so among you. But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, ⁴⁴and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all. ⁴⁵For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Expectation vs Reality


For the parade-goers then and for followers today, there is a tension between the Jesus we expect and the Jesus we get.

Expectation vs Reality


 People expect Jesus to free them from the Romans but Jesus came to províde víctory over sín.



"Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you."


