On January 1st, we lost our precious Yvenadelie to Tuberculosis. June 15th, we lost our faithful director's five year old son due to complications in a tonsillectomy. Our world was rocked. And then once again, in July, we lost our joyful Christian to hydrocephalus complications. In October, several staff and Natalie spent six weeks in the hospital with Jedidiah. Many children's deaths were witnessed and more trauma.

To say that our staff have not been affected, would be an extreme understatement. But what we have learned in pulling through...is that Jesus calls us to love deeply even in the risk of losing. He calls us to LOVE these children while they are here on earth and up until they are welcomed in to the Kingdom of Heaven. We began to pull through together with the mothers who have lost their children...TOGETHER. They have something beautiful to offer children who have no parents and we are seeing that come to fruition.

EXPERIENCE MINISTRIES

Reaches 300-600 community children every weekend and community worship.

Rescued 5 girls out of an illegal orphanage, transitioned 2 home and 1 to medical school, 2 in full time care.

One Gift, One Child is in Haiti to FIGHT FOR THOSE WITHOUT A VOICE.

We are here to PREVENT Orphans, Rescue, Redeem and Re-integrate in to family.

This means that we fight for children with disabilities whether they are in their biological family, in an abusive orphanage or in abandoned in a hospital. This means that we fight for women

in our community who are raped and beaten by their gangster boyfriends or husbands. This means that we fight for the children who are abandoned in orphanages and left to be abused because the leaders refuse to let the children go home to their families. This means that we fight for JUSTICE in a place of deep corruption.



Guerda works for Jerry House and been employed by OGOC for 1.5 years. She was in an abusive relationship, like many of our staff members. Her daughter, Fidnayda, has become a highlight of our ministry and our outreach program. When you visit our ministry, you see the strong family ties that our staff now have to their own children. Our goal is always to strengthen the family unit and to help with trauma and attachment issues in order for God to bring healing to their family and their hearts. When we see the Haitians STAND IN THE GAP for the orphans and the abused, then institutional orphanages will disappear and families will rise up.

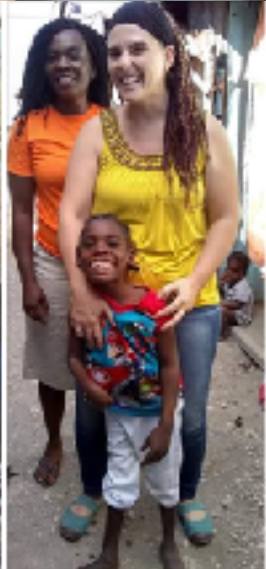

WHAT IS IN STORE FOR 2019?

Remember the orphanage we worked in for almost 2 years? We are solidifying our relationship with the local government and opening the JERICHO RESCUE CENTER. This is the same location as our community center (for now) and was always the plan to rescue these children out from that abusive orphanage. Some of our Zion girls still have siblings and cousins held hostage in that place of corruption, trafficking and abuse.

After 2 years of preparing the Lamer Kasè community through ministry and discipleship, our plan of shutting down the orphanage is finally coming true. We have pushed the government for two years and they say they are ready to MOVE in to ACTION. Our beautiful children that we loved deeply, are finally going to be rescued.

We are preparing our rescue transition center to receive a minimum of 30 children still left in that specific orphanage. Please pray as we work finish the details on the center (bath house and mattresses) as we prepare our staff as well. We are doing training and in need of hiring a MINIMUM of 15 staff members to help run the center. This means we are in need of monthly commitments to pay their salaries.

Natalie and possibly our social worker and Pierre are looking to go to Kenya at the end of January. There is an organization there that has a transition center that counseled and transitioned over 2100 street children back with their families. They have an 85% success rate of the family keeping that child and they oversee their families. Our goal is ALWAYS to strengthen the Haitian family and our rescue center will be turned in to a transition center where children will receive therapy to go back in to a family unit. Many of our children have been raised in abusive, institutional, tourism orphanages. It takes serious dedication and training and we are looking forward to getting our hands on a therapy/transition curriculum that has already been done for many years in the African culture. This should save us YEARS of trial and error...

So please be in prayer as we prepare for this part of our ministry. The government is ready and waiting. If you'd like to sponsor a salary position, most of our caretaker positions start at \$160 a month and go up to \$500 a month for the psychology/ social work positions. This is our biggest monthly need.
