# Handling Wrong Right"

#### **Big Idea**:

# -There is a *right* way and a *wrong* way to handle sin.

# -The right way leads to HAPPINESS and Freedom!

#### Verses 1-2:

**Blessed** is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. **Blessed** is the man whose sin the Lord does not count against Him and in whose spirit is no deceit.

### 1. The Good News!

#### God is in the business of forgiving sin

### Vs 1-2

David explains joy with three Hebrew words:

- Forgiven (Nasa)
- Having a burden lifted or covered (Kasa)
- Having a regretted action concealed and not counted/imputed – (Hasab)

David uses three Hebrew words for sin:

- (vs 1) "Transgressions" = Pesa
- (vs 2) "Sin"= Hataa
- (vs 3) "Iniquity/Guilt"= Awon

### 2. The Bad News

#### Sin Hurts- God is serious about sin

Vs 3-4

3 Ways David suffered when he failed to confess his sin

(vs 3) My bones wasted away
 (vs 4) Your hand was heavy upon me
 (vs 4) My strength was sapped

#### God has plan to deal with sin

#### David confesses his sins

- 3 synonyms for his confession; he
- 1. "Acknowledged" his sin
- 2. "Did not cover up or hide" sin
- 3. "Confessed" his sin to the Lord
